

- 1. The decision of the Judge is final. Shearing will be held under BISCA rules
- 2. Protests must be submitted to the Show Steward within one hour of the occurrence and accompanied by a deposit of £5.00.
- 3. Starting times of classes will be arranged by the Steward on the day of the Show.
- 4. Competitors are responsible for using safe working practises and using appropriate safety wear.
- 5. One vehicle pass and two exhibitor passes will be issued per exhibitor. Additional exhibitor passes must be ordered and paid for on this form at £15.00 each for adults, £5.00 for children (6 to 15). Any person travelling in a vehicle who does not have an exhibitor pass will have to pay the full Show day admission price (£21 adults, £9 children)

Blade shearing competitors to be booked in before 8.00am.

All machine shearing competitors must be booked in before 9.00am, classes to start at 8.30am.
